

GOLD CIRCLE MEMBERS PICNIC SITES

The Gold Circle Members' Picnic Sites have been a huge success. In response to the popularity of these track side sites, Gold Circle has made provision for 41 picnic sites for Gold Circle Members!

The sites have also been enlarged, two umbrellas will be provided for each site, and for your betting convenience, tote facilities have been incorporated into the layout of the picnic sites. To further improve your J&B Met experience, designated toilets have been allocated to the Gold Circle Member Picnic Site holders and a stronger security presence has also been arranged for the J&B Met 2010.

Member Picnic Sites are laid out in two rows - 22 sites in the first row along the rail, and 18 in a second row. If last year's experience is anything to go by, this is definitely the best place to enjoy the J&B Met.

The first row of sites closest to the track cost R2500 each, and the second row cost R2200 each.

What do you get for your money:-

- a 5.4 x 3.6 metre site - which is big enough for about 16 people
- 2 Brandhouse umbrellas
- 10 plastic chairs
- a 6-8 seat table
- tote facilities within easy reach
- designated toilets in reasonably close proximity
- 10 race cards

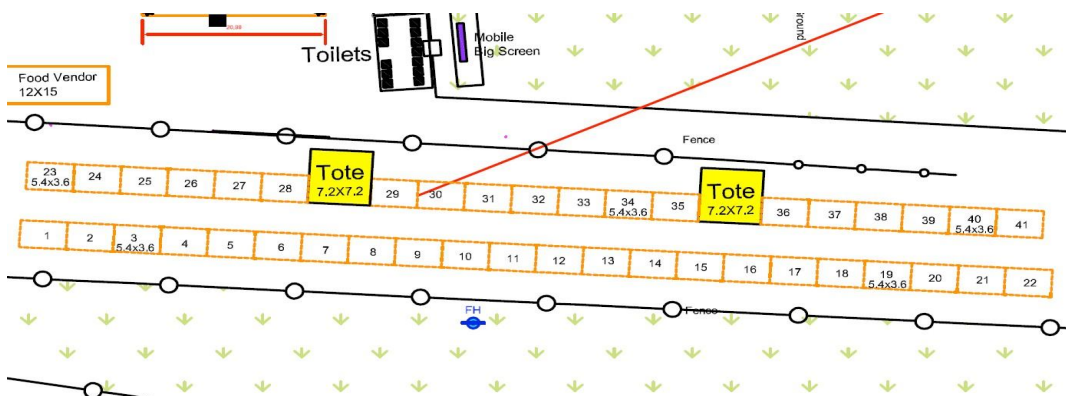
The perimeter of the sites will be fenced off – with access points at each end of the two rows of sites. Accreditation will be provided to site holders and security will be posted at the access points. Access control will not be so strict as to prevent friends of site holders visiting sites, however, general public, who wish to stroll through the sites, will be stopped from doing so.

Site holders will be responsible for the security of their own sites. Please ensure all guests are mindful of the need to look after their possessions.

Each site holder will be eligible for one Doncaster Road parking access ticket to make it easier to get food from vehicles to picnic sites. Other guests will need to park at Youngsfield at a cost of R50 per vehicle. Shuttle buses are provided from Youngsfield to Kenilworth from 09:00 to 24:00.

Site holders and their guests will be subject to the Rules & Regulations relating to Picnic Sites. A copy of the rules and regulations are available on request and on the Gold Circle Website. These rules and regulations are in addition to the rules of entry as detailed on the back of the J&B Met Ticket.

PICNIC SITE INFORMATION, RULES AND REGULATIONS

This information applies to Gold Circle Member Picnic Sites and the Gold Circle Picnic Site Village.

This information is in alphabetical order and must not be read as if in order of importance.

Alcohol

Order all alcohol from **Event Bars** by no later than FRIDAY 22nd January 2010. Collect alcohol on J&B Met Day between 07:00 and 13:00.

- *Gold Circle Member Picnic sites* - collect orders from the storeroom under the Grandstand.
- *Gold Circle Picnic Site Village sites* - collect from the Liquor Depot

You may not bring any alcohol to Kenilworth. Alcohol brought through the gates will be confiscated without compensation of any kind.

Ordering procedures will be provided when sites are booked. Bars will also be provided in close proximity to the sites which will allow you and your guests to buy more alcohol should you need to.

ATMs

ATMs and mini-BOB cash dispensers will be available in numerous locations at the J&B Met. Most totes will have the facility to draw cash.

Catering Services

Food delivery logistics will be confirmed closer to the time. All deliveries must be completed before 10:00 am on J&B Met Day. Vehicles will be provided to assist you to transport goods to your Village site.

Please make sure your caterers are aware of these arrangements and that you have people on site to meet your caterers and accompany the vehicles to your Village site.

ALL PERSONS ENTERING KENILWORTH MUST HAVE ENTRANCE ACCREDITATION.

Don'ts!

In addition to the conditions of entry on the reverse of the entrance ticket and as displayed at the entrances, the following rules and regulations will apply: -

- No music systems, DJ's, boom boxes, pc's/laptops as sound sources.
- No vehicles may be parked in the Village site area.
- No external branding or advertising of any description.
- No hi-jack marketing will be tolerated.
- No satellite dishes or decoders.

All Fire, Disaster Management, Health and Safety and Event Management requirements are to be complied with in full.

Electricity

Gold Circle Member Picnic Sites

Sites will not be provided with electricity. Generators may not be used.

Gold Circle Picnic Site Village

The 1st and 2nd rows in the Village will be provided with power. Each site will have two plugs, one for the television provided with your site and a second 15amp plug for your use. Please do not overload the plugs.

Only where practical and possible, may you use generators by prior arrangement - please contact Steven Adriaanzen.

Entrance Tickets

All persons entering Kenilworth racecourse require any one of the following: - Member or Member's Guest Accreditation armband, Entrance Ticket, or Complimentary Entry Ticket.

Entrance Tickets can be bought from most Gold Circle Totes, from Kenilworth Racecourse and from a number of stores in most major shopping centres in Cape Town. For information on where to buy tickets please contact Customer Information Service in 021 700 1621.

Entrance tickets will be on sale from MONDAY 7 DECEMBER 2009.

The ticket price of R150 per ticket includes a R10.00 betting voucher that can be redeemed for a bet on any of the races on J&B Met day and redeemed on any day from Monday 25 January 2010 to the end of the day on Saturday 30 January 2010.

Event Guide

When arriving at Kenilworth racecourse, a J&B Met Event Guide will be available.

The Guide includes the Programme for the day, information about the Kenilworth Conservation Area, various maps, a betting guide, information on how to read a horse's racing form and other useful information from each of the sponsors. In addition, the Guide includes important emergency contact information.

Infrastructure

Each site is provided with basic infrastructure. Site holders may not install any additional infrastructure or structures.

For the first time - additional "add-ons" are available to improve your site. When booking your sight review the list of add-ons and place your order.

All branding collateral - such as banners, feathers, collapsible gazebos, etc. - which bears the name of any company will be removed.

Open Flames

Absolutely NO open flames of any description will be allowed. No hay bales or other highly flammable material will be allowed.

Parking

No parking is available in the Picnic site areas.

Gold Circle Member Picnic Sites

Each site holder will be provided with a Doncaster Road parking access ticket.

All Gold Circle Members are entitled to park at Doncaster Road - please reserve a parking access ticket when completing the pre-registration form.

Guests of members can park at Youngsfield Army Base. Parking tickets cost R50 per car and can only be bought on entry to the parking area. A shuttle service between the parking area and the racecourse will be in operation from 10:00 until 24:00 (midnight).

Picnic Site holders and their guests can park at Youngsfield Army Base. Parking tickets cost R50 per car and can only be bought on entry to the parking area. A shuttle service between the parking area and the racecourse will be in operation from 10:00 until 24:00 (midnight).

Personal Safety

In order to ensure that you have a safe and fantastic "In Full Colour" J&B Met experience, the following steps have been implemented: -

- A strong police presence, both uniformed and plain clothed, will be in place.
- No unruly or violent behaviour will be tolerated.
- Any person behaving in a disruptive and unruly manner will be removed from the premises.
- Additional lighting has been installed.

Ensure that items of value - i.e. cell phones, bags, wallets etc - are left at home, or if brought to the event, not left lying around in plain sight. Please warn your guests to be vigilant and keep all personal items close at hand.

All security problems or concerns must be reported to the Joint Operations Centre - the "JOC". The JOC's contact number has not been finalised at the time of writing - please find the number in your Race Card and the official Event Guide.

Race Cards

An allocation of Race Cards will be provided to each picnic site - additional Race Cards will be on sale at the race course.

In addition to betting information lots of useful and interesting information has been included in the J&B Met Race Card.

Refuse / Rubbish

Collection of bagged refuse will take place throughout the day. Please ensure that your organisers/caterers have sufficient bags for rubbish. You will be shown where to place your rubbish for collection.

Rules of Entry

As a GOLD CIRCLE RACING EVENT, Right of Admission is reserved.

Attendee assumes all risk and danger incidental to the attendance of this event. The attendee releases the J&B Met 2010 sponsors, Gold Circle, Maru, The City of Cape Town, and Worldsport South Africa Group, and all directors, officers, employees, agents, representatives and/or other volunteers thereof, from any and all liabilities, damages costs and expenses arising out of/or relating to attendance at this event. In terms of the Financial Intelligence Centre Act (No. 38 of 2001), any person depositing, betting or collecting R25 000 or more must provide their full name, proof of identity and contact details.

Security

The area will be secured by security guards from Thursday morning. Although every effort will be made to secure the area and protect your goods, **Gold Circle does not take responsibility for any loss or damage of any kind whatsoever.**

Set-Up and Break Down

Site holders can access their sites from Thursday morning.

Two days have been allowed for load-in, set-up and decoration. All required infrastructure - furniture, bars, fridges, catering equipment, additional televisions - must be in place and fully installed by 18:00 on FRIDAY night, as NO vehicles will be allowed in on Saturday.

All infrastructure installed on site must be removed by no later than 18:00 on SUNDAY. No security will be provided thereafter.

Please note that the television sets provided by Gold Circle will be removed on Saturday evening after the running of the last race. Please ensure that access for the removal of the TV's is not hampered in any way by any of your infrastructure.

Although security will be provided through the night of the 30 January 2010, Gold Circle will not be responsible for any losses and or damage incurred during or after the event. Please provide your own security to protect your infrastructure, as no responsibility will be taken for loss for any reason whatsoever.

Suppliers

Should you wish to provide infrastructure and "add-ons" over and above that provided by Gold Circle you are free to deal with any suppliers, however, all suppliers will have to conform to all applicable regulations, time constraints and access limitations.

Please ensure that suppliers collect all goods by no later than 18:00 on SUNDAY 31 January 2010.

Televisions

Gold Circle Member Picnic Sites

Given the proximity to the huge Opti-screen - no televisions will be provided.

Gold Circle Picnic Site Village Sites

Each site will have a television with dedicated channels showing the following channels:-

- MET TV (fashion, racing, society)
- Teletrack - DStv 232 (racing information and betting odds)
- On Course Racing feed (Kenilworth Racecourse television – racing only)
- SABC 3 between 15:00 and 17:00 only
- Odds Display – Kenilworth Racing - Win/Place/Swingers
- Odds Display – Turfontein Racing - Win/Place/Swingers

Please note that the television sets provided by Gold Circle will be removed on Saturday evening after the running of the last race. Please ensure that access for the removal of the TV's is not hampered in any way by any of your infrastructure.

Toilets

Gold Circle Member Picnic Sites

Designated toilets have been demarcated for use by Picnic Sites guests. Only guests with the appropriate accreditation will be able to make use of the toilet facilities.

Gold Circle Picnic Site Village Sites

Toilets have been provided in numerous places in the Picnic Site Village. Site holders in rows 1, 2 and 3 will not be able to provide their own toilets due to space constraints and emergency access requirements. All toilets will have hand washing facilities, as well as an on-going janitor service.

Totes

Tote facilities will be in close proximity to all Picnic Sites.

As an **alternative**, use a telephone betting account! Open an account if you don't have one and don't forget to push up your balance before J&B Met day. For more information about opening a telephone betting, contact 080 131 4740.

RULES OF PICNIC SITE LIQUOR DEPOT J&B MET 2010

1. TRADING HOURS
The depot will open for collections at 7:00 on 30 January 2010 and will close at 13:00 on the same day.
2. FACILITY
An area will be set up as the liquor depot. The area will be fenced off and have sufficient security at all times. Orders will be placed over a counter and then be collected at a dispatch area.
Picnic site holders will be responsible for getting their orders to their sites.
3. OPERATIONS
All picnic sites holders must pre-order their liquor by FRIDAY 22nd January 2010.

All orders will be reviewed to control the amount of alcohol that is being ordered for each individual site.
4. CONTROLS
Liquor may not be brought into the venue at any stage on the day. All vehicles will be searched. These controls will be implemented by gate security, and the SAPS will be scrutinizing sites for liquor.
5. PAYMENTS
Once orders are received, each client will be invoiced and payment must be made as per invoice. Payee details will be on each invoice. NO ORDER WILL BE DESPATCHED WITHOUT PAYMENT!
6. GLASSES AND SMALLS
Due to excessive breakages and non-returns, the supplier will charge for all glasses, ice-bins and other smalls in full. On return of the goods, a refund will be given, less the rental charge.
