



## **DIRECTIONS TO GREYVILLE** **RACECOURSE**

### **FROM INLAND**

Proceed on the N3 until the Toll Gate Bridge. Take the turnoff immediately before the Tollgate Bridge or the one immediately after. Proceed down Berea Road (The road parallel to the N3). Turn left into Botanic Gardens Road (Immediately before the Technikon) and follow this road until Sydenham Road. Turn right into Sydenham which will take you to the South side of Greyville. If you have parking tickets in your possession continue along Sydenham which becomes Dartnell and then Mitchell Road:

- For pre-purchased PUBLIC PARKING ticket holders, turn left into DLI Avenue (under subway/bridge).
- For GOLD CIRCLE / ROYAL DURBAN MEMBERS PARKING ticket holders, continue straight and join the queue for the Members Parking entrance which is located just past the avenue of trees.

### **FROM SOUTH COAST**

Take the M4 freeway towards Durban. As you near the city take the Moore Road/ Berea turnoff. Proceed up Moore Road. Turn right at Cleaver which becomes Botanic Gardens Road. Follow this road until Sydenham Road. Turn right into Sydenham which will take you to the South side of Greyville. If you have parking tickets in your possession continue along Sydenham which becomes Dartnell and then Mitchell Road:

- For pre-purchased PUBLIC PARKING ticket holders, turn left into DLI Avenue (under subway/bridge).
- For GOLD CIRCLE / ROYAL DURBAN MEMBERS PARKING ticket holders, continue straight and join the queue for the Members Parking entrance which is located just past the avenue of trees.

Alternatively take the N2 north from near the airport. At the "Spaghetti Junction" take the fly off to the N3 to Durban. Then follow the directions for FROM INLAND above.

### **FROM NORTH COAST**

Take the M4 freeway towards Durban. At the robot at the end of the freeway turn right into Argyle Road. Turn left into Windemere Road and proceed around the circle into Mitchell Road (Avenue of trees will be on your right).

- For GOLD CIRCLE / ROYAL DURBAN MEMBERS PARKING ticket holders, proceed in a southerly direction until a break in the island enables you to join

the queue facing north. The Members Parking entrance is located just past the avenue of trees.

- For pre-purchased PUBLIC PARKING ticket holders, proceed to the robot and turn right into DLI Avenue (under subway/bridge)

Another option for holders of pre-purchased PUBLIC PARKING tickets is to proceed straight from the M4 along Stanger Street (now Stalwart Simelane Street), right into Ordnance Road, right into Field Street (green sign says R102 Umgeni Road) which becomes Albert Street, left fork into Epsom Road, straight into DLI Avenue.

## **PARKING**

The parking situation at Greyville Racecourse on Vodacom Durban July Day has improved dramatically over the past few years through the efforts of a number of people including the Metropolitan Police and Gold Circle's own security force. Further improvements will be made for the 2008 event but essentially there are a few simple rules to follow:

- Golf Course Parking will only be available to people who are in possession of a Parking Ticket.
- Pre-purchase your Parking Ticket from Greyville Racecourse before the day.
- Approach Greyville Racecourse from the side from which you will be entering the carpark.
- PUBLIC PARKING ticket holders can only access the parking via DLI Avenue from the City side. See above for directions.
- GOLD CIRCLE / ROYAL DURBAN MEMBERS PARKING ticket holders can only access their carpark through the special entrance which is located over the road from the old W. Daly's Building. See above for directions.
- Be patient when approaching Greyville Racecourse.
- Have your parking ticket ready to show to the Police, Security or attendants.
- Listen to members of the Police Force.
- Follow the appropriate signs.
- Once inside the Golf Course please park where directed in order to avoid blocking pre-planned thoroughfares.

### **NOTE:**

**GOLD CIRCLE / ROYAL DURBAN MEMBERS PARKING** tickets have a light blue and orange border.

**PUBLIC PARKING** tickets have a mustard and royal blue border.
